

FACTSHEET **TILBURG UNIVERSITY** **ONLINE EXCHANGE INITIATIVE** **FOLLOWING 1 OR 2 ONLINE COURSES**

The online exchange is a joint initiative of LUISS University, NHH Norwegian School of Economics, Tilburg University, Université Toulouse 1 Capitole, University of Mannheim, University of National and World Economy, and WU Vienna University of Economics and Business.

Students from the mentioned partner universities have the possibility to apply for online courses offered at other partner institutions subject to the details and conditions listed below. Please note that the conditions for application and admission differ from one institution to another depending on the local regulations.

Course regulations

Students have to be registered at their home university for the spring semester to be able to participate in the initiative. Master-level courses are open to Master students only. Courses not included in the course offer for ENGAGE are not available for ENGAGE participants.

Students need to meet the prerequisites of the courses at the start of the semester. Courses with specific conditions or quota are listed as such in the course overview.

The courses schedules will be published in the course catalogue by the end of December. We advise students to also plan to register for sufficient classes at their home university in case of scheduling conflicts for the Tilburg courses.

Application process	<p>Interested students from ENGAGE partners can indicate their choice to follow courses online by sending an e-mail to the Tilburg University Study Abroad and Exchange Team at studyabroad@tilburguniversity.edu by January 3, 2020 (extended deadline). Students have to indicate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> the number of courses they would like to follow (min. 1, max. 2), their course choices from the list linked above (<i>some backup options may be listed in case access to a course cannot be granted; please specify the order of preference</i>), and a recent transcript of records from their home university (in English). <p>In case there are more applicants from a partner than incoming exchange spots at Tilburg University (5 spots per ENGAGE partner), the selection is based on the number of courses for which the student applies (the more courses, the better the chance) and the student's GPA.</p> <p>Students whose application cannot be accepted because the number of 5 spots per ENGAGE partner was exceeded, will be put on a waitlist and informed of this via e-mail. There is no guarantee that they can be admitted later on. The Study Abroad & Exchange Team will communicate this possibility to the individual student if it becomes available.</p>																					
Application period	<p>The deadline for pre-application is January 3, 2021 (extended deadline). Students will be informed about the outcome of their application shortly thereafter and will be sent registration information for Tilburg University to complete by January 8, 2021.</p>																					
<p>Grading</p> <p>The Dutch grading system uses grades from 1 (worst) up to 10 (best).
