Application process	<p>Interested students can apply by sending an e-mail to engage@unwe.bg (Subject: "Application to Online Exchange Initiative").</p> <p>Application requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Bachelor's level: enrollment in a bachelor's program at a partner university; minimum of one year of full-time studies completed (60 ECTS-Credits). ➤ Master's level: enrollment in a master's program at a partner university. <p>Application documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Confirmation of enrollment home university ➤ Transcript of records ➤ Statement of purpose, incl. courses you would like to attend <p>The selection will be based on an evaluation of the applicant's overall academic performance (transcript of records) and the statement of purpose. UNWE will notify its partner universities about the selected students. Partner universities have to confirm their students admission to UNWE's courses.</p>
Application period	<p>The application period runs from December 14 to January 11, 2021.</p> <p>All applicants will be informed about the outcome of their application at the latest by January 18, 2021.</p>
Fees and other administrative aspects	<p>No administrative and/or tuition fees will be charged.</p> <p>Costs for expenditures like reading materials, literature would have to be borne by the students (if applicable).</p>
